



ANT Photo Library - Digital Submissions guidelines

Our minimum specifications of Digital files from a Digital Camera:

1. Files must come from a camera with a minimum eight mega-pixel chip in an SLR camera
2. The images need to be shot in RAW format.
3. Please use the Adobe RGB (1998) profile setting
4. If your camera will shoot in 16 Bit, please shoot, process the images and supply them to us as a16 Bit Tiff for PC
5. You need to correct the file for Colour and Exposure. Please make sure that you do not clip the highlights or shadows. We would rather have a flatter looking image that has the maximum tonal range available to us
6. Do not apply any sharpening
7. The file needs to be supplied to us as a 300dpi RGB Tiff for PC
8. At no stage convert the files to CYMK, compress or interpolate them please as these three processes degrade the file.

All submissions should be sent as final hi-res Tiffs to the specifications above.

We would rather not have your files embedded in some sort of viewing software please.

Captions: Please use the Excel file, available from the ANT Photo Library website, fill in all the relevant caption details against the file name.

Please clearly label your PC formatted DVD with your name and contact number. Once we have edited your work we will notify you of the number of images that we have taken into the library.

Your first digital submission.

Before submitting work to us for the first time in digital format we recommend you send 10 or so hi-res files at the above specifications. This gives you the opportunity to confirm that your technical settings match our requirements.
